

I Isaac William Healy lay impropriator of the Parish of Kilpiper in the County of Wicklow and Wexford and Diocese of Ferns, do hereby Certify, that previous to the sixteenth day of February last past, I did receive from Daniel Tighe Esq^r a Notice in writing under hand, declaring himself desirous of agreeing for and undertaking the future payment of the Compositions for tithes payable out of the lands of Ballymanus in said Parish of Kilpiper, and I certify that the following is a true Copy of the Notice referred to and served upon me. - to wit -

To. Mr. Isaac William Healy, lay-Impropriator of the Great Tithes of Ballymanus in the Parish of Kilpiper -

Sir I hereby give you Notice as lay-Rector or lay-Impropriator of the Parish of Kilpiper, or of that part thereof in which the Town-land of Ballymanus is situated, that I am desirous pursuant to the provision of the Statute of the 2nd & 3rd of W^m the 4th Chap 119. to agree for and undertake the future payment of the Tithes Compositions (deducting therefrom 15 p^{ct} Cent for Ann^{ty}) which is due for the great or Rectorial tithes out of my Estate of Ballymanus, in the Parish of Kilpiper in the Barony of Ballynacorney, and Co of Wicklow, which Estate I hold in fee-simple, and which contains 686 Acres Irish Plantation measure or thereabouts. The said lands of Ballymanus are bounded on the N. W. by the lands of Coolballintagart, Bokinagap and Slieve-mile, S. W. by the lands of Bokinagap, S. E. by the lands of Killyduff, and N. E. by the river of Sloughain which divides them from the lands of Cappagh, Croftill &c, in the Parish or Union of Rathdown, I have therefore to request that you will furnish me with an Account of the Tithes payable out of said lands, and also the Certificate required by the 22nd Section of the above mentioned Act of Parliament -
