Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and twenty four a Certificate  
for the Parish of Kilspipe in the Diocese of Ferm in Ireland  
was lodged with the Registrar of the Bishop of the said Diocese  
and now appears and is entered and recorded in the Registry of the  
said Diocese in the Words and Figures following to Wit  
"We Benjamin Cross and Henry Dwyer Commissioners duly  
"Appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made  
"in the fourth Year of the Reign of George the Fourth intituled  
"An Act for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in  
"Ireland for a limited Time to ascertain and fix a true and  
"just composition of all Tithes arising growing yielded or  
"payable within the Parish of Kilspipe in the Counties of  
"Wicklow and Wexford Do hereby Certify that the true and  
"just amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatever within the  
"said Parish is Three Hundred and Thirty six Pounds by the  
"Year of which Sum of Three Hundred and Thirty six Pounds  
"One Hundred and Ninety five Pounds are due and payable to  
"Bridget Huggenbotham as a Composition for the Tithes  
"claimable by her as Vicar of the Rectorial Tithes and One  
"Hundred and forty Pounds is due and payable to Ralph  
"Cummins the Vicar And we do further Certify that the  
"Average price of Cows being the Corn principally grown  
"in such Counties for the period of seven Years ending the  
"first day of November 1824 is fifteen Shillings and two  
"pence farthing per Borell And We do further
