

" Certify that the average amount of the Rectorial Tithes taken
 " from Documents laid before Us appeared to be One Hundred
 " and Sixty two pounds ten Shillings to which sum of One
 " Hundred and Sixty two pounds ten Shillings we have added
 " One fifth Part Thirty two pounds ten Shillings making
 " in the whole One Hundred and Seventy four Pounds
 " the Rectorial Tithes being Two Thirds of the Tithes of the Parish
 " of Kilpiper were in lease to John Boland and Patrick Cullen
 " for Thirty one Year which Lease expired on the first of
 " May 1819. We could obtain no Documents to take the average
 " for four Years except receipts for the yearly reserved Rent
 " of Eighty four Pounds and the Vicaral Tithes being one Third
 " appeared to Us to have amounted to One Hundred and Twenty
 " Pounds per Year during the same period Given Under our
 " Hand the fifteenth day of April Eighteen Hundred
 " and twenty four - Benjamin Coates }

And Whereas Bridget Signibrookham in the said Certificate
 named being a person entitled to a portion of Tithes in the
 said Parish of Kilpiper as aforesaid duly appeared to Us
 the Lord Lieutenant in Council stating among other things
 and complaining that altho' it is expressly enacted by
 the 16th Section of said Act that the amount of the
 Composition shall be calculated upon an average of all
 the sums paid or agreed for or adjudged to be paid
 in such Parish or account of Tithes during the Seven
 Successive Years preceding the 1st day of November 1823
 Yet said Coates and Dore the Commissioners without
 any Evidence before them of the sums paid or agreed for or
 adjudged to be paid for or in respect of Rectorial Tithes in
 said Parish during any part of the first four Years of said
 pretended period of Seven Years and without any Evidence
 now of adoption the Rent paid to said Boland and Cullen
 in said Certificate mentioned who have held said Tithes by
 virtue of a Lease made for 31 Years which expired in 1819
 during
