

I Ralph Cumine the Appropiate Curate of the Parish of Kilpiper in the County of Wicklow and Oxford and Diocese of Ferns, do hereby Certify that previous to the Sixteenth day of February last past I did receive from Daniel Fyfe Esq^r a Notice in writing under hand declaring himself desirous of agreeing for and undertaking the future payment of the Composition for tithes of that part of the said Parish of Kilpiper in the Co of Wicklow, and in the Diocese of Ferns which as mentioned in the said Notice I am entitled to the receipt of as the Ecclesiastical Decumbent of the said Parish and which is charged upon and payable out of the following lands therein mentioned, and therein described by the following mete and bounds and lying and being within the said Parish of Kilpiper, to wit, the Town and land of Ballinacree bounded on the North West by the lands of Corballintogash, Askinnogash and Shevinnile, on the South West by the lands of Arkleady and Ballyglin, on the South East by the lands of Kellyduff and on the North East by the River of Aughrim separating the Estate of Ballinacree from the lands of Cappagh, Crapill & Rosahane in the Parish of Rathdrum - and also by the said Notice stating that his title in and to the said several lands so charged with such Composition, and so described in aforesaid and bound as aforesaid was held by him in fee simple - Now, I, the said Appropiate Curate do pursuant to the directions for that purpose given in and by an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland in the Second and Third years of the reign of His Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the Establishment
