Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for ~~all~~ Tithes arising growing yielded or payable
within the Parish of Kilpiper in the Counties
of Wicklow and Wexford do hereby certify that
the true and just amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the said Parish (pursuant
to agreement) is four hundred and ten Pounds
by the Year of which sum of four hundred and
ten Pounds two hundred and fifty Pounds are due
and payable to Bridget Higginbotham as Composi-
tion for the Tithe claimable by her as owner of the
Rectorial Tithes, and one hundred and sixty
Pounds are due and payable to Ralph Cumine
the Vicar of the said Parish.

And we do further certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown
in such Counties for the period of seven years
ending on the first day of November one thousand
eight hundred and twentyone is fifteen Shillings
and two pence farthing per Barrel
Given under our hands this sixteenth day of March
eighteen hundred and twentyfive
