

The Honble St John Butler Commissione, duly
appointed, and sworn (under and by vir-
tue of an act made in the second, third
yeare of the Reigne of King William the fourth,
intituled an act, to amend three act passed
respectively, in the fourth, fifth, & in the
seventh, eighth yeares, of the reigne of His late
Majesty, King George the fourth, pro-
viding for the establishing of compositions
for tithes in Ireland, and to make such
compositions permanent) to see & asse-
tain a true & just composition for all
tithes, arising, growing, yielded, or payable
within the Parish of Redpatrick, in the
County of Londonderry, do hereby certify,
that the true, & just amount of compositions
for all tithes whatsoever, within the said
Parish is, Thirty three pound, thirteen
Shillings, & ten pence farthing, which
Sum of Thirty three pound, thirteen
Shillings and ten pence farthing, is
due, and payable, to the Bishop of the
Diocese. And I do further certify,
that
