

The Honble^d J. John Butler, commissioners
duly appointed, and sworn, (under and by
virtue, of an act made, in the second, & third
year, of the reign, of King William the fourth,
intituled, an act, to amend three acts, passed
respectively, in the fourth, fifth, and in
the seventh, & eighth years, of the reign, of
his late Majesty, King George the Fourth,
providing, for the establishing, of composi-
tions for tithes in Ireland, and to make
such compositions permanent.) To
ascertain, & fix, a true, & just composition
for all tithes, arising, growing, yielded, or
payable, within the parish of Kilquane,
in the County of Limerick, do hereby certify,
that the true, & just amount, of composition
for all tithes whatever, within the said
parish is, sixty six pound, six Shil-
lings, & one penny three farthings, which
sum of sixty six pound, six Shillings
& one penny three farthings, is due,
and payable, to the Bishop of the
Diocese
