King George the Fourth, to ascertain & fix a
true & just composition for all Tithes arising
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of
Milquon, in the United Diocese of Down & Connor
County of Kerry - Do certify
truly, that the true & just amount of composition
for all Tithes whatsover within the said Parish,
is One Hundred & Two Pounds fifteen Shillings &
fourpence halfpenny ¹⁰ by the year, which sum
of One Hundred & Two Pounds fifteen Shillings &
fourpence halfpenny ¹⁰ is due & payable to the
Rev^d Joseph Mandelin as a composition for
the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of
said Parish - And we do further certify that
the average price of oats being the corn principally
grown for the period of seven years ending the
first Day of Nov^r 1821, was fifteen Shillings
& Two pence ¹⁰ for Barrell of Dungannon Stone
