

# Tithe Composition

I Silvester Rait having been duly appointed and sworn Commissioner under, and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, and by virtue of an Act passed in the second and third years of the Reign of His Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively, in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh, and eighth, years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, and to ascertain and fix a true & just Amount of Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish Kilremny in County of Wiltshire, Do hereby certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever, within the said Parish, arising out of the following Towns Lands Viz: Kilremny, Cornamuckla, Ballinlig and Kilglaf, is Forty five pounds Stg. by the year, out of which Sum of £45 Stg. the proportion of Fifteen Pounds, or one third part is due & payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Charles Palmer as Sequesterator
