

Tilbury - 1741. 2. 7<sup>th</sup>

We John Lathell and Mark Belcher Commissioners duly appointed  
and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth  
Year of the Reign of King George the fourth Entitled an Act  
to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes  
in Ireland and also an Amendment of said Act passed  
in the fifth Year of the Reign of King George the fourth  
to ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition for all  
tithes arising Growing Yielding and payable within  
the Parish of Tilbury in the County of Wiltshire do  
humbly certify that the true and Just amount of  
Compositions for all Tithes whatsoever within the said  
Parish is One Hundred and Forty One pounds Two  
Shillings and Seven pence Three farthings per annum  
which sum is due and payable to the Reverend  
Thomas Humm as Rector and Vicar of said parish  
and we do further Certify that the said sum of One  
Hundred and Forty one pounds Two Shillings and  
Seven pence Three farthings is a Just and fair composition  
for said tithes as agreed upon at a Vestry duly assembled  
for the full End and term of Twenty One years  
from the first day of Nov 1741 one thousand eight  
Hundred and twenty four without any variation  
whatsoever
