

Certificate of Composition for the
Tithes
of the Parish of Kilruane
Diocese of Killaloe & County Tipperary.
£ 214¹⁰ 18¹⁰ Irish Money

We the Rev^d Melton Gresson and William Evans Esq.
Commissioners duly appointed & sworn under & by virtue
of an Act made in the 4th year of King George the 4th
intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time
to ascertain & fix a true & just Composition for all Tithes
arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of
Kilruane in the County of Tipperary. Do hereby Certify
that an agreement having been entered into according to
the 2^d Section, on the part of the Rev^d Rector & the Vestry
incumbent to accept of the Sum of two hundred pounds per
Annum in Liew of the Tithes signed by said Rev^d
Rector & seven Parishioners assembled in
Special Vestry & dated 27th March 1824 we have duly
enquired & find the average amount of the Sums actually
paid during the seven years preceding 1st November
1821 to be two hundred & fourteen pounds eighteen Shillings
& ten pence half penny per one year & that the true & just
amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoev^r within the
said Parish is two hundred & fourteen pounds eighteen
Shillings & ten pence half penny by the year. And that
the entire of said Sum of two hundred & fourteen pounds
eighteen Shillings & ten pence half penny Sterling is due
& payable to the Rev^d Rector & Vestry of said Parish.

And we further Certify that the average price of Oats
being the Corn principally grown in said County for

the period of seven years ending the 1st day of
November 1821 is fifteen Shillings & two pence sterling
per Bushell
