Tipperary, Do hereby Certify that an agreement having
been entered into, according to the 27th Section, on the part of
the Rev^d Cuthbert Fetherston H Incumbent to accept of the
sum of two hundred pounds per Annum in Lieu of the Tithes
signed by said Rev^d Cuthbert Fetherston H & seven Parishioners
assembled in Special Vestry & dated 31st March 1824 we have
duly enquired & find the Average Amount of the Sum
actually paid during the seven years preceding 1st November
1821 to be two hundred & fourteen pounds eighteen Shillings
& ten pence for one year & that the true & just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is two hundred & fourteen pounds eighteen
Shillings & ten pence Sterling by the year - And
