Joseph Wilson as a Composition for all Tythes claimed by him as Rector and Vicar of said Parish -

And we do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ending the first Day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty One is One pound Eighteen shillings and Eight pence Half penny per Bant.
