We Simon O'Donnell and Mich^l Brew^r Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the 4th year of the reign of King George the 4th intituled "an Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" and also an Act made in the 5th year of the reign of the said King intituled "An Act to amend the same" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable within the Parish of Kibruisk in the County of Clare do hereby Certify that at a Special Vestry duly assembled at Kibruisk in the said Parish of Kibruisk on the 28th day of November last for the purpose of carrying into execution the purposes of the said Acts. That the Reverend Swine Whitty Vicar of said Parish of Kibruisk did then and there enter into an agreement with the Chairman and members of the said Vestry so assembled, for the sum of One hundred and sixty five pounds by the year as a Composition for his part of the Tithes of the said Parish and that he the said Rev^d Swine Whitty did for and in behalf of the Rev^d Standish Grady Rector of the said Parish agree with the said Chairman and Vestry for the sum of Two hundred and sixty pounds by the year as a Composition for his part of the Tithes of said Parish of Kibruisk, and that Bindon Scott Esq^r entered into an agreement as aforesaid with the Chairman and Vestry for the sum of Forty pounds by the year as Composition for his part of the Improvise Tithes of the said Parish of Kibruisk, which sums amounting in the whole to the sum of Four hundred and sixty five pounds ~~shall be~~ Consider a just and fair Composition for the Tithes of the said Parish and also that such Composition shall be and remain in full force and effect for the whole space of Twenty one years and shall not be subject to any variation in the amount thereof during such period of Twenty one years what ever the price of Corn may be
