

pounds for every hundred pound
which is advanced, as specified
in the act of Parliament made
and provided for that purpose,
a cess of seven pence farthing
per acre be hereby levied
on this parish, so as that
the sum of £465.0.0 arising
from the collection of such
cess be paid on the first day of
July in every year to the
Treasurer of the Board of
first fruits, till the
original loan of £765.0.0
be entirely and completely
liquidated, the first payment
of this cess to be made

on the first day of July 1812.
It was also unanimously resolved
that our Churchwardens,
James Wilson of Conston
and Robert Frayth of the
Castleton Esqrs, are
hereby appointed to receive
this money, and that
their receipts for it
shall be sufficient;
given under our hands in
vestry assembled this 13th
day of January 1811 eleven
