Fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, entitled "An Act
for the Composition of all Tithes in Ireland, to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding
or payable within the Parish of Kilsaran in the County of Louth,
Do hereby Certify that the amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatever within the Parish of Kilsaran is £359 1 6/ Three
Hundred and fifty nine Pounds, one shilling and six pence by
the year, being the amount agreed upon between the Rev William
Woolsey Incumbent of the said Parish and the Parishioners only
assembled at Vestry on the tenth day of September one Thousand
Eight hundred and twenty eight under said Act, all which sum
of Three Hundred and fifty nine Pounds, one shilling and six pence
is due and payable to the said Rev William Woolsey as Rector
of said Parish of Kilsaran. And We do further Certify that the
Average Price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in
said Parish in said County for the Period of seven years ending
on the first day of November one Thousand Eight hundred and
twenty one, is Thirty eight shillings and eight pence half penny
late Irish currency, being equal to thirty five shillings and
eight pence three farthings by the Barrel,
Dated this Thirtieth day of July one Thousand
Eight hundred and twenty nine
