Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatevver within the Parish of
Kilsenny, is one hundred and fifty eight pounds Shill. by the year
of which Sum of one hundred and fifty eight pounds, the Sum of one hundred
and fifty pounds are due and payable, to Richard Michael -
Spoldeldams Esq. (As. Lay) Impropriator - And Eight pounds
of the one hundred and fifty eight pounds are due and payable
to the very Rev. William Henry Stapleton Deme of Kilsenny
as owner of the Rectory, Tithes of the said Parish of Kilsenny
in the Diocess of Kildare & Kilsenny

And I do further Certify that the average price
of oats being the Corn principally grown in said Parish and County
for the period of the last seven years, ending on the first day
of Nov 1830 is at the rate of twelve Shillings & eleven pence per bush
