

We William Henry Waller & Henry Cairns Commissioners
specially appointed by an Act under the Great Seal of Great
Britain made in the fourth year of the Reign of King
George the fourth, entitled An Act to provide for
the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix
a true & just Composition for all Tithes, arising,
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish
of Kilsbinn in the County of Meath, do hereby certify
that the true & just amount of Compositions for all
Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is one
Hundred Pounds by the year: which sum of one
Hundred Pounds is due & payable to the Rector
of said Parish, as a Composition for all Tithes
claimable by him out of said Parish.

The above sum of one Hundred Pounds a year having
been certified to us as a true & just amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish, by a Vestry
held at Kilsbinn, where seven Parishioners were duly assembled
& signed by them & a Chairman under the 27th clause
in the above recited Act.
