growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of
Keshmullagh in the County of Kerry do hereby certify
that the true and just amount of Composition for
all tithes whatever within the said Parish is One
hundred and eighty Pounds by the year, the
entire of which is due and payable to the Reverend
John Murphy as a Composition for the tithes claim-
able by him as Rector of the said Parish.
And we further certify that the average price of Oats
being the Corn principally grown in the County is
10. 15. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ Dated this 23rd day of April 1825—
