duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue  
of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of  
King George the fourth entitled "an act to provide  
for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in  
Ireland for a limited time" and also of an act  
made in the fifth year of the reign of King George  
the fourth to amend the same entitled "an act  
to amend an act of the last session of Parliament  
for providing for the establishing of composition  
for Tithes in Ireland" &c. To ascertain and fix  
a true and just composition for all Tithes arising,  
growing, yielded, or payable within the parish of  
Miltale in the county of Meath and Diocese of  
Meath do hereby certify, that the true and just  
amount of composition for all Tithes whatever  
within the said parish is Seventy one pounds  
five shillings by the year - which sum of Seventy  
one pounds five shillings is due and payable to  
George Fisher Esq. (yearly) as Tithe-owner of said  
parish -

and we do further certify that the average  
price of Oats being the corn principally grown  
in the county of Meath for the period of seven years  
ending on the first day of November eighteen hundred  
and twenty one is fifteen shillings and two pence  
farthing per Barrel -
