-sition for all Tithes, arising, growing, yielded,  
or payable within the Parish of Milsillagh in  
the County of Cork, do hereby Certify, that the  
true and just amount of Composition for all  
Tithes whatever within the said Parish, is Forty  
Two pounds fourteen shillings and two pence  
sterling, by the year of which sum of Forty two pounds  
fourteen shillings and two pence sterling, Forty two  
pounds fourteen shillings and Two pence sterling are due

And payable to the Mord James Stewart as  
composition for the Tithe claimable by him as  
Rector and vicar of the said Parish ~  
And I do further Certify, That the average  
price of wheat, being the Corn principally grown  
in such County, for the period of Seven years next  
preceding the first Day of November One thousand  
eight hundred and Thirty, is One pound Twelve  
shillings and Ten pence half penny per barrel -
