

that the amount of said composition in said parish for the said Improprate Tithes and the Rent charge payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished to such an extent that the amount of such diminished composition and Rent charge shall bear the like proportion to the amount of the original composition as the said average price of seventeen shillings and five pence three farthings per barrell so ascertained by the said Justices as aforesaid bears to the average price of one pound twelve shillings and one halfpenny per barrell as stated in the said certificate of composition And the said Justices do further order that the applotment of such composition shall be amended and diminished accordingly and that the said diminution shall take effect from the first day of November 1896.
