I Ebenezer Radford the Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the 2^d & 3^d of King W^m the 4th Intituled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th and in the 7th & 8th year of the reign of his late Majesty King George ^{the fourth} providing for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Miltigan in the County of Tipperary Do hereby ^{certify} that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish of Miltigan is Amety three pounds thirteen Shillings & ten pence per annum and which sum of Ninety three pounds thirteen Shillings and ten pence are due and payable to the Rev^d Robert Carey as Rector and Vicar of said Parish And I do further Certify that the Average Price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said Parish for the Period of Seven Years preceding the first of November 1830 thirty was one Pound nine shillings and nine pence per barrel of twenty Stone
