

Monday 27th September 1824

at a Special Vestry held this day in Doonagh Church
for the Parish of Kiltinanahilly, for the purpose of
taking into consideration the Certificate of the
Commissioners acting under the late ~~Act~~
Composition Bill, it appearing by said Certificate
that £300 yearly was the Sum agreed upon by
the Parishioners of said Parish to be paid to Rev. Geo.
Winstroff Rector and Vicar of said Parish it is
further agreed upon that said Certificate shall be
with drawn from the Register or Vicar General
of the Diocese and that the above Sum
be advanced to Three Hundred & Seventy
Sterling per Annum for the
Commencement of the said ~~Year~~ 1st November
next 1824, in Witness whereof the Rector
and Parishioners have hereunto put their Names
and that Joseph Wallace Esqre & William
Welsh Esqre, are to sign a further
Certificate for the said Three Hundred and
Seventy Pounds Sterl, pursuant to the Act of
Parliament
