Sir

I beg to say that having applied to Mr. Handy  
 your agent for payment of the Rent charge due by you  
 to Mr. Archdeacon Handy out of the Lands of  
 Kilkenny, he did not wish to pay as the demand was  
 a few shillings more than he was in the habit of  
 paying formerly, and requested me to forward you  
 an extract from the Appointments which I do  
 in the next page -

When I was appointed Agent to Archdeacon Handy &  
 Collector on the Returns made by the former Agent,  
 but on the Annexation of the Lands of Kilkenny to the  
 Rent Charge the Ecclesiastical Commissioners  
 fixed the Income above what we were in the habit  
 of receiving, therefore I was directed by Mr. Handy  
 to go carefully over the Appointments and see if there  
 was an Error and if so correct it, I have done so &  
 find that yours and others were short of what you  
 ought to pay, we do not go back but must go strictly  
 by the Appointments in future which are correct as I  
 have compared them word for word with the originals in
