

To all to whom these presents shall come, I the Reverend Thomas Jones Rector Vicar of the Parish of Kiltobert in the Diocese of Ardagh send Greeting. Whereas Walter Jones Esquire, pursuant to Two several acts of Parliaments passed respectively in the Second and Third, and in the Third and Fourth years of the Reign of his present Majesty King William the Fourth being acts to amend Three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth and Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, did serve a notice in writing upon me as Incumbent of said Parish, bearing date the twenty second day of July last, stating that he was desirous of agreeing for and undertaking the future payment of the amount of the Composition for Tithes payable out of the Lands of Mung, Gowel, and Derryhalla, bounded as therein mentioned, and as by a Map or Plan thereof hereto annexed appears, which said several Lands the said Walter Jones holds in the Parish of Kiltobert, in Fee, and the said Walter Jones did thereby undertake the future payment of such Composition for Tithes, conformable to the Terms and provisions of said acts of Parliament - Now I know all that by these presents, that I the said Reverend Thomas Jones do hereby Certify and declare that he the said Walter Jones Esquire did cause such notice to be duly served upon me, and that he is the Person entitled to the benefit thereof, pursuant to the provisions of said acts of Parliament -
