do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of
Composition for all Tythes whatsoever within the said Parish
is Five Hundred Pounds by the Year which Sum is due
and payable to the Reverend Thomas Jones as Rector
and Vicar of said Parishes

And We do further Certify that
the Average Price of Oats being the Corn principally
grown in such County for the Period of Seven Years
ending on the first day of January 1833 is Nine
Shillings per Barrel
