

Earl of Mulgrave Lord Lieutenant General and General Governor of Ireland by and with the advice and consent of the Privy Council of Ireland, that the Certificate of Composition for the tithes of the Parish of Kinnegagh hereinbefore recited and set forth be altered and amended as prayed by the Appellants, by expunging thereout the words "Hugh Cumming Esq as Lay Proprietor or Lord of the Soil" and the words "John D Buckell Esq as Lay Proprietor or Lord of the Soil" and inserting therein in lieu and stead of the said words the following words "The Reverend John Whitty, as Incumbent of the Parish of Rathmore" And that the said Certificate and the entry thereof in the Registry of the said Diocese be altered and amended accordingly. And it is hereby further Ordered that the parties Defendants as aforesaid DO pay unto the said Reverend John Whitty, the Costs incurred by him in all proceedings before this Board, in prosecuting his said Appeal and Memorial from and after the 2nd of July, 1827. the Date of the passing of the Act of the 7th and 8th George the 4th Cap 60. giving power to award costs in such Appeals. such costs to be Taxed by one of the Masters of the High Court of Chancery, to whom the same are hereby referred for Taxation accordingly, if the parties concerned shall have any difference in relation thereto.
