

We Joseph Fulkerson and William Young
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under
and by virtue of an act made in the fourth
year of the Reign of King George the fourth
entitled an act to provide for establishing of
compensation for tithes in Ireland for a limited
time and also of our other act made in the
fifth year of the Reign of his said Majesty
King George the fourth entitled an act
to amend an act of the last Session of
Parliament for providing for the establishing
of compensation of tithes in Ireland to ascertain
and fix a time and just compensation for
all tithes arising growing yielding or
payable within the Parish of Kinnearagh
in the counties of Kildare and Carlow
as hereby certify that the true and just
amount of compensation for all tithes whatsoever
within the said Parish is Four Hundred
and three pounds ten shillings and eleven
pence by the year of what sum one third of
that sum that is payable or to be paid
of the Lands of Caragen in the said Parish of
Kinnearagh and County Kildare are due
and payable to his Grace the Duke of Devonshire
from the year 1790 to the year 1800
