in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth "entitled an Act
to provide for the Establishment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a
limited time" do ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all
Tithes arising growing ~~yielding~~ payable within the parish of Kinnigh in the
Diocese and County of Cor K. Do certify hereby that the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish and payable out of
the entire thereof to the Reverend Abraham Hamilton and claimed by him
as Vicar of said Parish is Four hundred and fifty pounds British Sterling by
the Year, the sum of two hundred and twenty five pounds payable by the
Year to the Reverend Henry Theophilus Moore Rodder as Chanter of the
Cathedral Church of Saint Trin Barry out of the ~~several~~ ~~lands~~ ~~of~~ ~~the~~ ~~parish~~ ~~to~~ ~~which~~ ~~he~~ ~~is~~ ~~entitled~~ ~~as~~ ~~such~~ ~~Chanter~~ ~~and~~ ~~the~~ ~~sum~~ ~~of~~ ~~Two~~
Hundred and twenty five pounds British Sterling payable by the Year
to the Reverend the Vicars Choral of said Cathedral Church of Saint Trin
Barry out of the several lands of said Parish to which they are
entitled as appropriators of said Parish said three respective sums making
together the sum of Nine hundred pounds British Sterling by the Year
and being the respective sums agreed upon between the Parishioners and
the said respective owners of the Tithes of said Parish at a special Vestry
lately summoned and held in pursuance of the directions of the above
mentioned Acts, It having also been agreed upon at the said Vestry
that the said respective sums be paid annually in lieu of all Tithes
for the term of twenty one years without any variation or alteration

whatsoever
