

I John Kidd, Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of his Majesty King, William the Fourth entitled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King, George the Fourth providing for the Establishing, of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition within the parish of Skinnigh in the Diocese of Cork and County of Cork for all that portion of the tithes of said parish being the tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable out of and within the District, Ploughlands or Townlands of Monagoue East and Monagoue West, alias Monagan East and Monagan West, alias Moneygoue East and Moneygoue West, part and parcel of the said Parish, do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said District, Ploughlands or Townlands of Monagoue East and Monagoue West, alias Monagan East and Monagan West, alias Moneygoue East and Moneygoue West is Eighty Five Pounds two Shillings & Eight Pence ~~ster~~ by the year, which sum is due and payable to his Grace The Duke of Devonshire as a Composition for all the Tithes claimable by him as Lay Impropriator of the said Tithes of and within the said District, Ploughlands or Townlands of Monagoue East and Monagoue West, alias Monagan East and Monagan West, alias Moneygoue East and Moneygoue West, part, parcel and portion of the said parish of Skinnigh in the County of Cork aforesaid. And I do further Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County during the period ending the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty is one pound twelve Shillings and one halfpenny per Barrel, and that the average price of Oats during the same period is Twelve shillings and eleven pence halfpenny per Barrel, Wheat and Oats being the Corn principally grown in the County of Cork.
