ascertain And fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable
within the Parish of Kinnilly in the Kings County, do
hereby Certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the
said Parish is one hundred and eighty five
pounds of which one hundred and eighty five pounds
one hundred and thirty one shillings and payable to
the Hon^{ble} & Rev^d I Grandee as a composition for the
Tithes claimable by him as Rector and Dean of
said Parish And the sum of thirty five pounds
are due and payable to Thomas Henderson Esq^r
And the sum of thirty pounds are due and payable
to the Representatives or Assignees of Joseph Tait
as lay Impropriators of a portion of the Tithes
of certain Denominations in said Parish, And
We do further Certify, that the average price of
wheat being the corn principally grown in said
County for the period of seven years ending the
