virtue of a Act made in the fourth year of George the
fourth entitled an act to provide for the establishment
of the composition of tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all tithes arising, growing
yielded, or Payable, within the Parish of Kinsale in the
county of Cork do hereby certify that the true and just
amount of the composition for all the tithes whatsoever
within the said Parish of Kinsale is thirty three Pounds
two shillings and six pence by the year of which sixteen
Pounds eleven shillings and three pence is due and Pay-
able to the Reverend James Thomas Browne as
Rector of the said parish and that the Remainder
sixteen Pounds Eleven shillings and three pence
are due and Payable to The Rector of the said Parish and I do
further certify that the average Price of Wheat
being the corn principally grown in this County for
the period of seven years ending the 1st day of
November 1830 is one Pound twelve shillings and one
half Penny
