

We Rob<sup>t</sup> Fitzgerald of Navinstown and Tho<sup>s</sup> Atkinson  
of Drogheda Commissioners duly appointed & sworn  
under and by virtue of an act made in the Fourth year  
of the Reign of King George the Fourth intituled "An  
Act to provide for the establishing of the Compositions  
for tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain  
and fix a true and just composition for all Vicarial  
tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within  
the parish of Navinstown in the County & Diocese  
of Kildare. Do hereby certify that the true and just  
amount of Compositions for all Vicarial tithes whatever  
within the said Parish is Twelve Pounds Twelve Shillings  
British Sterling by the year. And that the said sum of  
Twelve Pounds Twelve Shillings is due and payable to  
the Very Rev<sup>d</sup> John Bayly Dean of Kildare as a  
composition for the tithes claimable by him as Vicar  
of the said Parish. And we do further certify that the  
average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown  
in such County for the period of seven years ending on  
the thirty first day of October one thousand Eight hundred  
& twenty one is One Pound Eighteen Shillings & Eight  
Pence halfpenny late Irish Currency equal to One Pound  
fifteen Shillings & eight pence halfpenny British
