"the establishment of Compositions for tithes in Ireland  
"for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just com-  
position for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable  
within the Parish of Knight in the County of Tipperary.  
do hereby certify that the true and just amount of com-  
position for all tithes whatever within the said Parish  
is two hundred and eighty six pounds three shillings  
and one penny <sup>British</sup> by the year, which sum is due and pay-  
able to the Rev. <sup>British</sup> Archdeacon Fetherston, as a composition  
for the tithes claimable by him as Rector and Vicar  
of the said Parish. And we do further certify that the  
average price of wheat, being the corn principally grown  
in such County for the period of seven years ending on  
the first day of Nov. 1821. is thirty eight shillings and  
eight pence half penny of <sup>British</sup> Parols dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day  
of Aug. 1826
