Arising, Growing, Yielded or payable in the Parish of Knock
in the Union of Drakestown in the County of Meath do
hereby Certify that the true and just Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the Parish of Knock in said Union
is thirty eight Pounds five Shillings and five Pence and are due and payable
to the Rev^d Robert Longfield as a Composition for the Tithes
Claimed by him as Rector of said Parish in said Union -
And we do hereby Certify that the Average Price of Oats being
the Corn Principally grown in such County for the Period of
Seven Years Ending on the first day of November 1821
is fifteen Shillings & Two Pence three farthings late Irish
Currency - Dated the 1st day of December 1829
