

The William Hawkes and John Wiseman Commissioners appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of King George the fourth Entitled "an Act to provide for the Establishing of Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time" and also of an Act made in the fifth year of the Reign of King George the fourth Entitled "an Act to amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament for providing for the Establishing of Composition for tithes in Ireland" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of Knockavilla in the County of Cork.

Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Six hundred and Twenty five pounds Sterling by the year for the term of Twenty one years invariable and not subject to averages. Payable to the Reverend William Lewis Beauport Rector and Ecclesiastical Incumbent of said Parish pursuant to an agreement entered into by the said William Lewis Beauport and a Special Vestry of said Parish.
