We John Doherty & Robt Dexter Commissioners appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth intituled an act to provide for the establishing of Comproction for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just Comproction for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Knockgraffon in the county of Lifford, Do certify that the true and just amount of Comproction for all Tithes whateve within the said Parish is Seven Hundred and Seventy pounds by the year of which sum of Seven Hundred and Seventy pounds the entire is due and payable to the Rev^d Nich^{ls} Herbert as a comproction for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of said Parish -

And we do further certify that the average price of wheat being the corn principally grown in said county for the period of Seven years ending on the first day of Nov^r 1821 is thirty eight shillings and eight pence $\frac{1}{2}$ p^{ts} Barrell

At an adjoined Vestry held in the Parish Church of Knockgraffon to satisfy the terms agreed on at the former Vestry it was unanimously agreed by the Chairman and Parishes assembled that the sum of Seven Hundred and Seventy pounds be paid to the Rev^d Nich^{ls} Herbert Incumbent annually in Lieu of all Tithes growing and arising out of said Parish of Knockgraffon invariably for twenty one years
