Certify that the True and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Two Hundred pounds British
Sterling, by the Year, are due and payable to
the Rev^d. William Liddiard as a Composition for
all Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the
said Parish,

And We do further Certify that
the average price of wheat being the corn
principally grown in such County for the
period of seven years ending on the first
day of November in the Year, one Thousand
Eight Hundred and Twenty one, is one pound
eighteen shillings and eight pence half penny
Irish per Barrel, Given under our hands
