Take Notice that an application will be made to the Justices
of the Peace of the County of Dublin assembled at Quarter Sessions to be holden
at Middleton in and for the Division of Middleton in the County of Dublin East
Riding on Friday the 20th day of October 1893 by us the undersigned Owners
of Land in the said Parish of Knockmourne each charged with the annual
payment of £3 or upwards in respect of Tithe Composition and Tithe Rent
Charge that the Tithe Composition and Tithe Rent Charge in the said Parish
may be varied and diminished pursuant to the several acts relating
to Tithe Composition and Tithe Rent Charge in Ireland, and for
that purpose that the average price of Oats as advertised in the Public
Gazette for the seven years preceding the year 1893 be inquired of and
ascertained in order that the composition for Tithes and Tithe Rent
Charge in the said Parish of Knockmourne may be varied and
diminished for the ensuing seven years in proportion to such average
price, and the Assessment and Apportionment thereof varied and
diminished accordingly.
