

for establishing Tithe composition in Ireland to ascertain
and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes x
arising growing yielded and payable within the Parish
of Knockmowne in the County of Cork did certify under
his hand that the true and just amount of Composition
for all Tithes within said Parish was then One thousand
and seventy nine pounds twelve shillings and nine pence
by the year of which sum one half part was due and
payable to The Reverend Thomas Campion D.D. as a
composition for the Tithe claimed by him as Vicar of said
Parish and the other half was due and payable to the x
Corporation of Waterford as lay proprietor of said Parish
and further that the average price of oats being the corn
principally grown in said County for the period of seven
years ending the First day of November One thousand
eight hundred and thirty was Twelve Shillings and
eleven pence ha'penny per barrel. And whereas
His Grace Spencer Compton Duke of Devonshire &c. &c.
Henry Braddell Esquire, George ab Pyne Esquire, esq^r
Isabella Matilda Gumbleton, Philip H. Pope Esquire
esq^r Deborah Hodder and esq^r Michael Flynn being
three and more persons in said Parish of Knockmowne
each charged with the annual payment of Three pounds
sterling and upwards in respect of the Rentcharge now
payable in said Parish in view of said Tithe composition
caused a Notice in writing signed by each of them to
be affixed to the principal outer door of the Church of

said Parish and also on the principal outer doors of every
known place of religious worship in said Parish on two
successive Sundays that is to say on Sunday the thirtyfirst
day of May one thousand eight hundred and ninety six
and on Sunday the seventh day of June one thousand eight
hundred and ninety six signifying their intent to apply
and that they would apply to the Justices of the Peace for
the County of Cork assembled at the next ensuing general
Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for said County that
is to say the general Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be held
at Fermoy in and for said County and in and for Cork
County East Riding and Division of Coddleton (being the
County Riding and Division in which said Parish is situate)
the eighteenth day of June one thousand eight hundred
and ninety six to have the average price of oats being 12.
corn in said original Certificate of said John Ross &
mentioned for the seven years preceding inquired of and
ascertained from the Dublin Gazette in order that the amount
of said Tithe composition and the Rentcharge now payable
in view thereof in said Parish may be varied and increased
or diminished and the apportionment thereof varied and
amended for the seven years ensuing the First day of
November one thousand eight hundred and ninety six in
proportion to such average price when ascertained as aforesaid
and to have the Tithe composition and Rentcharge and the
apportionment thereof varied and increased or diminished
