the Justices assembled at the said general Quarter Sessions
of the Peace and was duly heard and considered by said
Justices and after debate was by Order of said Justices then
and there made adjourned to the then ensuing general
Quarter Sessions ^{in and for said County Riding and Division that is to say the general Quarter} of the Peace held at Middleton in and for
said County on the third day of November One thousand
eight hundred and ninety six for further consideration. And
Whereas said application duly came on for hearing at said
last mentioned general Quarter Sessions of the Peace, before
the Justices there assembled the said Third day of November
One thousand eight hundred and ninety six in presence
of said Applicants and their Counsel and of Counsel for the
said the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough

of Waterford claiming to be entitled as Say Impropriator
And after further debate was by Order of said Justices then
and there made further adjourned to the next ensuing
general Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for said County
Riding and Division that is to say the general Quarter
Sessions of the Peace held at Fermoy in and for said County
Riding and Division the twentyeighth day of January One
thousand eight hundred and ninety seven for further consideration.
And the said application having come on for hearing before
the Justices assembled at said last mentioned general
Quarter Sessions ^{pursuant to said Order of adjournment} of the Peace, in presence of Counsel for the
said Applicants and of Counsel for the Mayor, Aldermen
and Burgesses of the Borough of Waterford claiming as
aforesaid, said Justices upon proof of the premises and
upon hearing Counsel for the Applicants and also Counsel
for said Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough
of Waterford by their Order then and there made ordered
that the average price of good marketable oats for the
term of seven years ^{next} preceding said application be inquired
of and ascertained from the Dublin Gazette and nominated
and appointed Edward Beard Esquire of Ballintubber in
the County of Cork to be an Arbitrator for ascertaining
the average price of the barrel of good marketable
oats for the said term of seven years from the Dublin
Gazette and to state and set forth such average price
by his Report in writing under his hand to be delivered
to the Justices of the Peace assembled at the next
