And Whereas said general Quarter Sessions to which said application was first made as aforesaid have been continued thence hereunto for the purposes of said application. And Whereas said Edward Heard pursuant to said last mentioned Order has made his Report in writing under his hand to said Justices and has thereby stated and certified that he has ascertained from the Dublin Gazette the average price of the barrel of good marketable Oats for the term of seven years preceding said application and that said average price is *Eleven shillings and one penny*.

And the said application having pursuant to said last mentioned Order come on for hearing before us the Justices assembled at these present general Quarter Sessions of the Peace and said Edward Heard having presented to us his Report in writing as aforesaid. Now we the said Justices having duly considered said Report and having heard what was urged by Counsel on behalf of said Applicants and also by Counsel on behalf of the said Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Waterford claiming to be entitled to said Composition

and Rentecharge as Lay Impropriator of said Parish do hereby find determine and adjudge that the average price of good marketable Oats for the seven years preceding said application as ascertained from the Dublin Gazette is *eleven shillings and one penny* by the barrel and that the said average price varies by more than a tenth from the average price of Oats set forth in the said Original Certificate of said John Hojs and accordingly we do adjudge and Order that the Composition for all Rentes and the Rentecharge in lieu thereof now payable in said parts of said Parish of Knockmourne to the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Waterford as Lay Impropriator of said Parish be varied and diminished for the seven years ensuing the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and ninety six in such manner and to such extent that the amount of such Composition and Rentecharge for and during the said seven years ensuing said first day of November One thousand eight hundred and ninety six shall bear the like proportion to the amount of the Composition set forth in said Original Certificate of said John Hojs as payable to said Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Waterford as said Lay Impropriator and the Rentecharge heretofore payable in lieu thereof as the average price of the barrel of Oats for the
