At a special vestry duly holden in the Parish of
Kingsdown, on Tuesday the tenth day of May Instant, for
the purpose of taking into consideration the Commissioners' Certificate
of Composition for the tithes of said Parish —

Resolved, that we hereby agree and assent on behalf
of the owners and occupiers of Land in said Parish, to the
payment of the amount of Composition for the tithes of said
Parish, as contained in the Certificate of Composition hereto
attached. And that the amount of said Composition viz
Two hundred and fifty Pounds by the year, shall not be
subject to any variation in the amount thereof for the term
of Twenty one years, from the first day of May next ensuing
the date of said Certificate, whatever the price of Corn may
be in the mean time. And that this meeting fully
approves of said Certificate —
