sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the
second and third years of the reign of King William
the fourth Intituled an act to amend three acts, passed
respectively the 1st 5th 7th & 8th years of his Late
Majesty King George the 4th providing for the Establishing
of Composition for tithes in Ireland and to make such
Composition permanent to a certain and fix a true
and just Composition for all tithes arising growing
yielding and payable within the Parish of Knocktopher
in the County of Kilkenny do hereby Certify that
the true and just amount of Composition for all
tithes whatever within the said parish is one hundred
and seventy five pounds by the year which sum
is due and payable to the Rev^d Hans Hamilton as
Rector of said parish as a Composition for all tithes
Claimed by him within said Parish. Thereby
further Certify that the average price of Wheat being
the Corn principally grown in such County for the
period of seven years ending 1st Nov^r 1830
is one pound twelve Shillings one half penny
