of which sum of One hundred and twenty one pounds  
three Shillings and three pence Steling is due and payable  
to the said Rev<sup>d</sup>. Thomas Strange as Rector and Vicar  
of the said Parish of Kyles.

And we do further Certify that the  
average price of wheat being the Corn principally  
grown in said Queens County for the seven years preceding  
the first day of November 1821 is One pound Eighteen  
Shillings and Eight pence halfpenny per Barrel.  
Given under our hands this 12<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1823.
