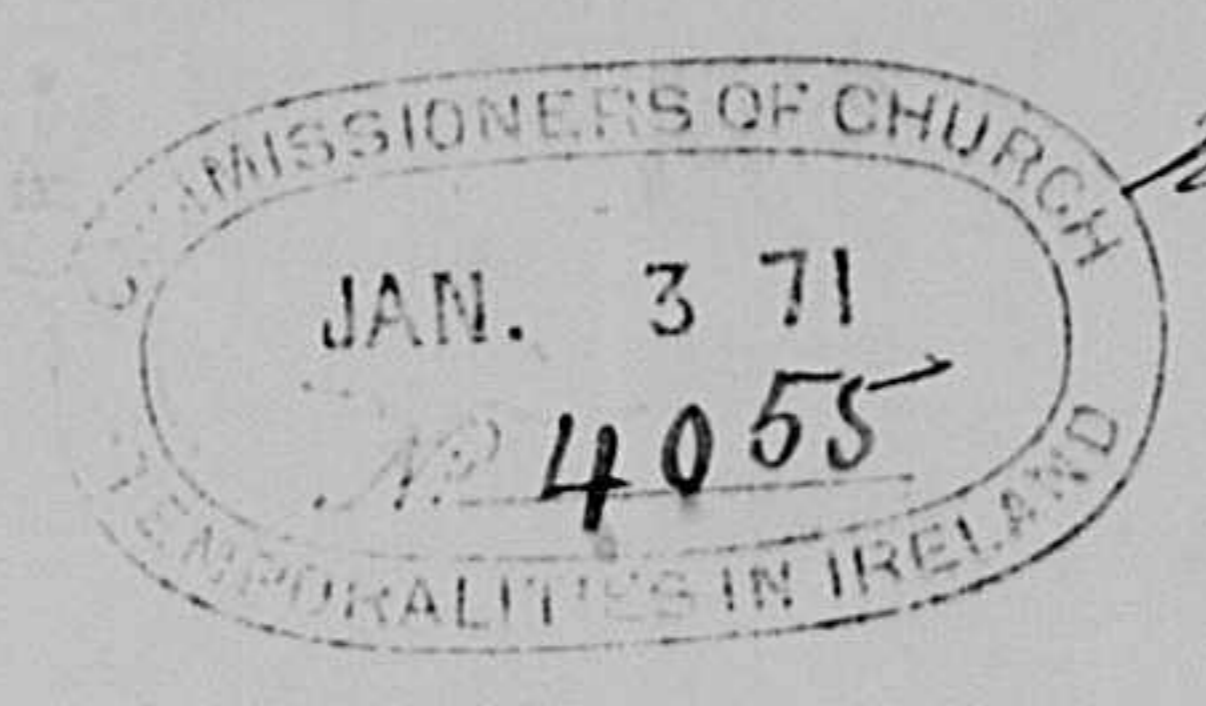

Sir,
 My Curate - the Rev. John Dwyer
 Russell has resigned with my leave the
 Curacy of Roscrea.
 I beg to claim from the Comm^{rs} of
 Church Temporalities the sum of £100 -
 per annum which was deducted from
 my Rent Charge - & to have it added
 to the Annuity of £376 - 9 6 allowed
 to me as Rector of Roscrea.
 I was appointed as Vicar of the
 Comm^{rs} for Co. Wick in 1868 & in
 1869 I was appointed for the Vicar of
 Clangar & Belmullet - holding the
 same for three years. I have
 not yet received any reply.
