

The Robert FitzGerald Esquire of New town and The Rev^d William Cox Rector of
Nurney Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act
made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George The Fourth (intituled an Act
to provide for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited Time)
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded,
or payable within the Parish of Laeka in the County and Diocese of Kildare, do hereby
certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Two hundred and fifty eight pounds nine Shillings and two
pence halfpenny British by the year. And that the said Sum of Two hundred,
and fifty eight pounds nine Shillings and two pence halfpenny British, is due
and payable to the Rev^d Joshua De Gree as a Composition for the tithes claimable
by him as Rector and Vicar of said Parish yearly -

And We do further certify that the Average Price of Wheat being the Corn
principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the
thirty first day of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is One
pound eighteen Shillings and eight pence halfpenny late Irish Currency,
equal to One pound fifteen Shillings and eight pence halfpenny British.
