

We the Rev. Patrick Tanos and Jonathan Nugent Esqrs. Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made
in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth intitled an Act
to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true & just composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the
Parish of Larabogan, or Maynooth in the County of Wicklow, and
Arch. Diocese of Dublin, to which the Rev. Gilbert Austin as Vicar
of said Parish is intitled. Do hereby Certify that the true and
just amount of Composition for said Tithes within the said Parish
is Four Hundred Pounds by the year. Pursuant to an Agreement
made, entered into, and unanimously confirmed by and between
the said Gilbert Austin, and the Parishes of said Parish. And
that we have levied the same on each Town Land & Denomination
according to the best of our Skill and Judgment. And we
further Certify, that the Average price of Wheat, being the
Corn principally grown in said Parish for the period of
Seven Years, Ending on the First day of November 1821 (one)
is one Pound Eighteen Shillings and Eight pence Half penny
per Barrel. Given under our Hands at Maynooth the 28th day of
February 1825.
