

No 6 Duplicate of the
Certificate of the Commissioners appointed pursuant
to the Act 4th Geo 4th intitled an Act to provide
for the establishing of composition for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time

We Jonathan Nugent Esq^r of Barrack County
Meath and the Rev^d Patrick Sands Vicar of Cel-
bridge &c in the Diocese of Dublin & Co Kildare
having been duly appointed & sworn under
&c by virtue of the above mentioned Act to
ascertain & fix a true & just composition
for all Tithes in the Parish of Larabryan or
Maynooth in the Diocese of Dublin & County
of Kildare to which the Vicar the Rev^d Gilbert
Austin shall for a limited time be entitled

— An unanimous agreement having been
entered into by the Parishioners & the said
incumbent the Rev^d Gilbert Austin that he
should receive in lieu of all tithes due &
growing & payable to him — Four hundred
pounds Ster^s. per annum payable according
to the provisions of the said Act —

— We Jonathan Nugent & the Rev^d
Patrick Sands the Commissioners aforesaid
appointed by the Parish & incumbent aforesaid

do agree to this amount of composition as
just & equitable & accordingly as we are
bounden by the said act give our consent
to the same & sign this our certificate
accordingly. Given under our hands
at Maynooth this 21st day of Sept^r 1824
